TRAVELLING TO AND FROM SCHOOL

BIKES & SCOOTERS

Students in Kindergarten - Year 2. We require an adult family member to accompany students riding to and from school. This does not include an older sibling at the school. We have the safety of the students in mind with this requirement whilst the younger students develop their road safety awareness.



Students from Years 3 - 6, are permitted to ride their bike/scooter to and from school, ensuring safe riding habits and necessary safety items including helmets, are worn.

WALKING

With safety in mind, we encourage families to collect students from school in Kindergarten-Year 2 to support their knowledge of safely walking on footpaths and crossing roads as required. Again, we require an adult family member to accompany students walking to and from school, not an older sibling.



BUSES

There are four buses that service Denman Public School. These buses have limited seats available and bus passes are issued through the bus company. Please give the bus company accurate address details so we can ensure the safety of all students travelling home.



These buses travel to and from;

- · Sandy Hollow (includes Hollydene and Mangoola)
- Muswellbrook
- Dalswinton and Jerrys Plains Road (includes Golden Highway and Dalswinton Road)
- · Yarrawa, Bureen and Grey Gum Road.

Students are expected to behave in an acceptable manner whilst travelling on buses.

A brief afternoon assembly is conducted at 2.50pm to advise students of changes in their normal routine. Any change to your child's routine must be communicated to the office by **no later than 2.45pm**.

PAXTON STREET CARPARK

Please note the church car park across the from the school entry is a private parking space.

Please do not park there for school events, or drop off and pick up. Families are welcome to park at the back of the school and enter during the back gate for large events if Paxton Street is full.

Bus Flashing Lights Campaign

Term 1 2025 from 31st January



Slow down to 40km/h when bus lights flash, unless a lower speed limit applies.

Key Messages

Motorists

- Lights flash on buses to warn motorists that buses are picking up and dropping off children
- You must slow down to 40km/h when overtaking or passing a bus displaying flashing lights, unless a lower speed limit applies.
- You can help keep children safe by:
- Sticking to the speed limit and following the road rules in school zones
- Slowing down to 40km/h when bus lights are flashing, unless a lower speed limit applies
- Looking out for children crossing the road near bus stops, in school zones or along bus routes
- Giving way to buses when they merge back into traffic.

Families

- Families have an important part to play in keeping children safe around roads.
- Never drop off or meet your child on the opposite side of the road to the bus stop or call them
 across the road. Always drop them off or meet them on the same side of the road as the bus
 stop.
- Remind your children to always wait until the bus has gone before choosing a safe place to cross the road
- Talk to your children about Stop! Look! Listen! Think! every time they cross the road:
- Stop one step back from the kerb
- Look continuously both ways
- Listen for the sounds of approaching traffic
- Think whether it is safe to cross and keep checking until safely across.






