Layla has been doing a fantastic job building her reading skills by applying new and challenging digraphs.






Year 1 Frankie








Year 2 Indy

Keep up the fantastic work Aubree!






Year 4 Imogen

Imogen continues to apply and use learnt strategies in maths with great success. She demonstrates great persistence and determination in all maths lessons. Great job Imogen!






Year 5 Lizabelle


