Ruby J - Trying her absolute best when faced with challenges at Milson Island. Trying new things and never giving up!



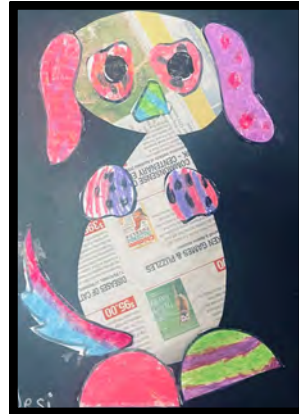

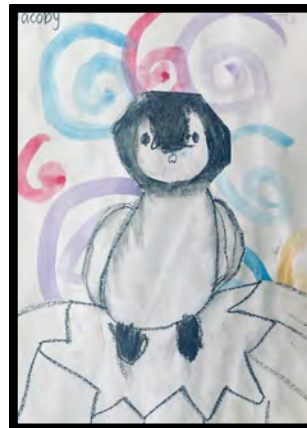

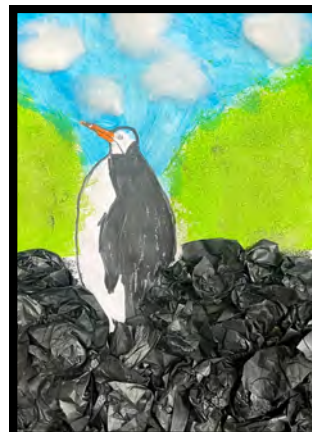

Lilly - Kindergarten

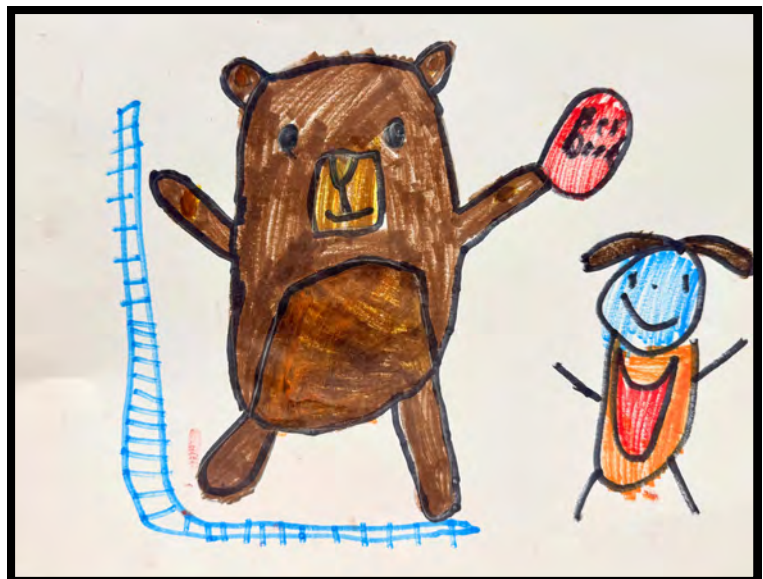
In maths, Lilly always tries her best. She has been working on adding numbers, by counting from the highest number in visible collections. Great work Lilly!

Huxley

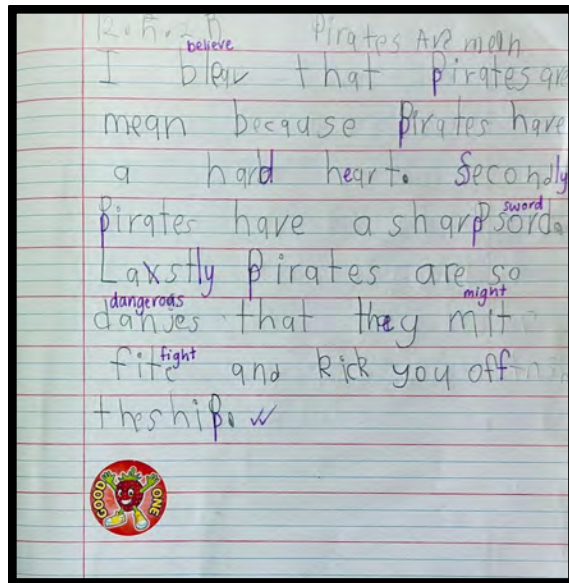

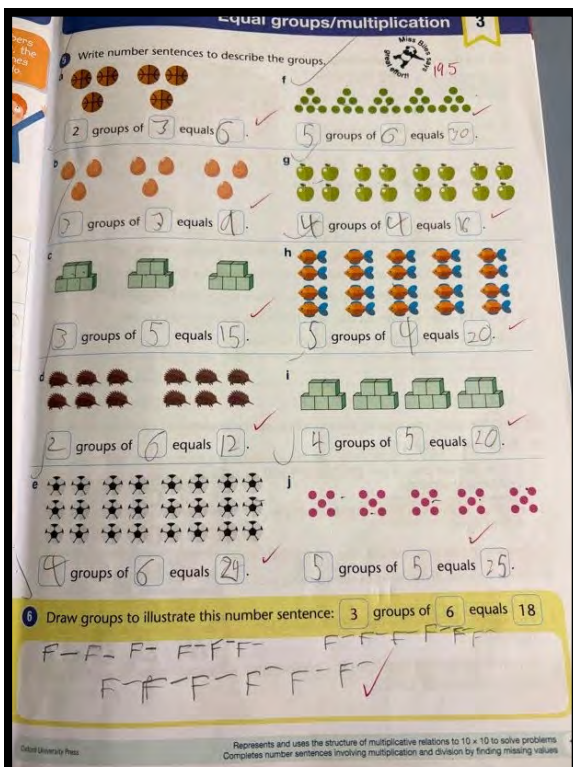
Year 2

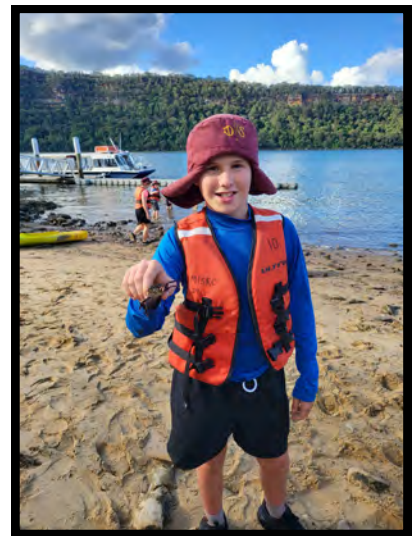

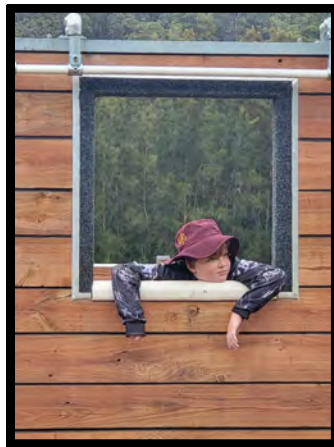
