

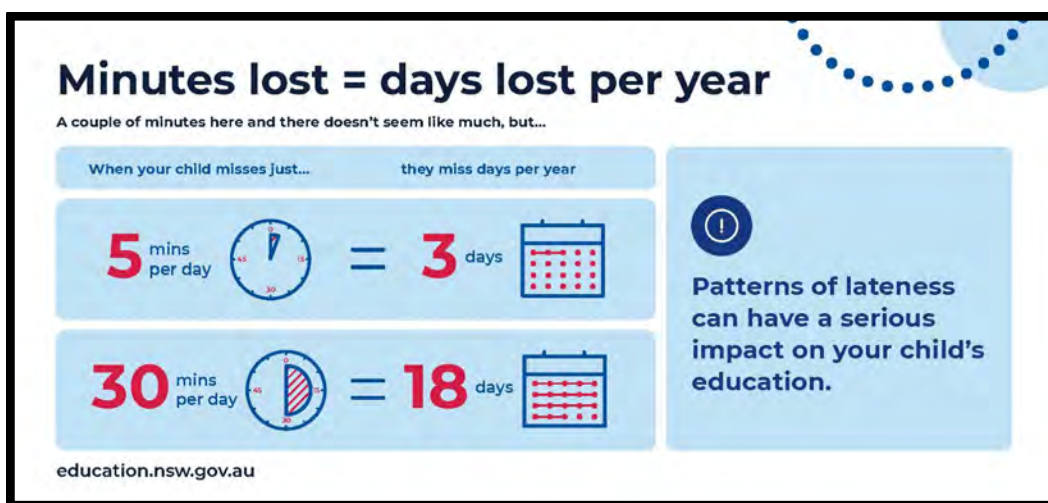

Finn - Demonstrating remarkable growth and resilience during the Spelling Bee practice. Great work Finn!

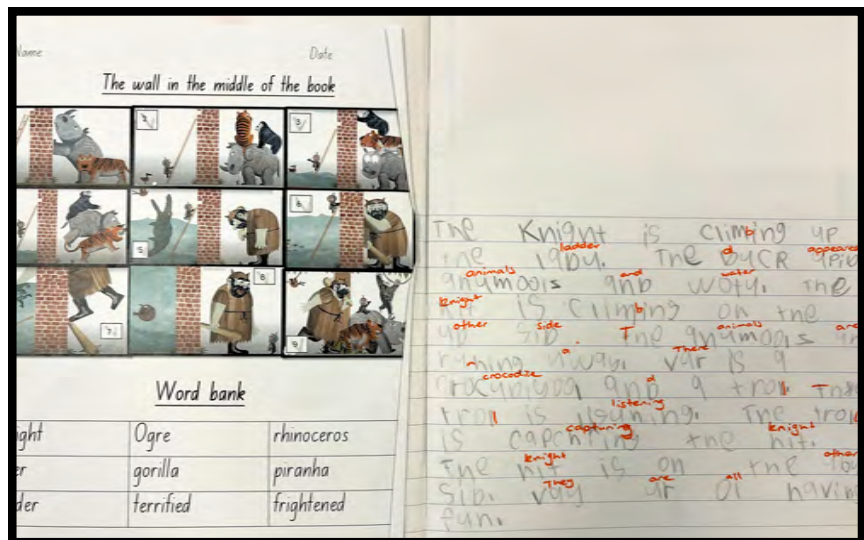


WONDERFUL WORK

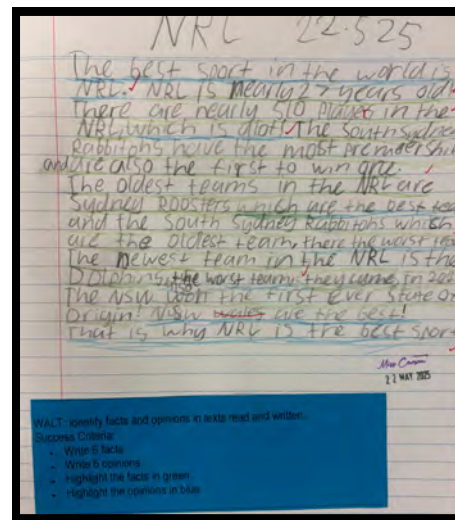


WONDERFUL WORK

Cohen

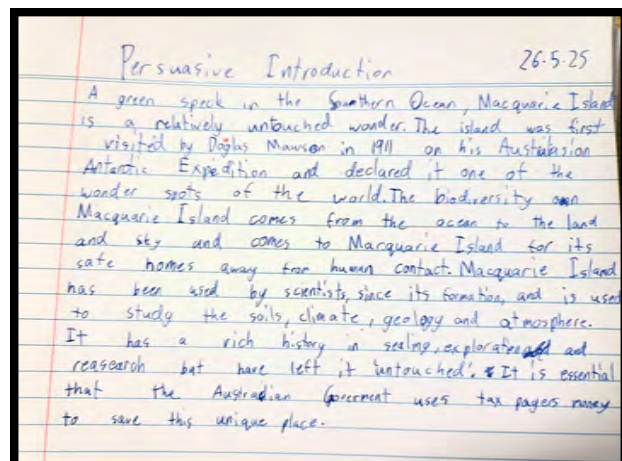

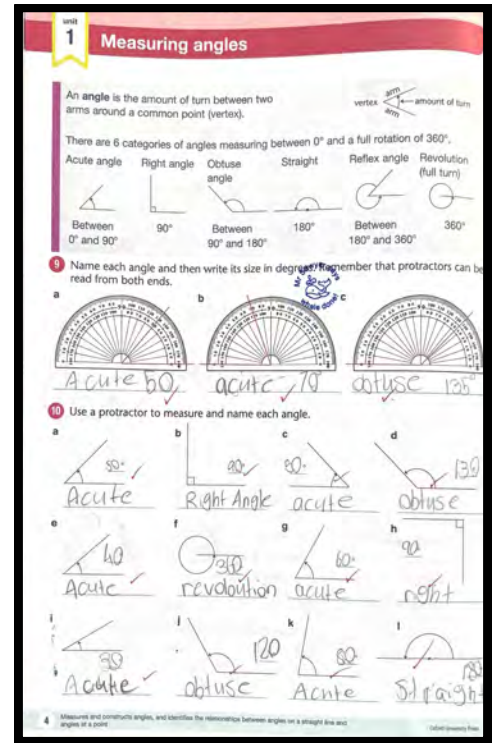
