Emilia - Demonstrating outstanding resilience to present her fantastic speech about gemstones at the Public Speaking finals.

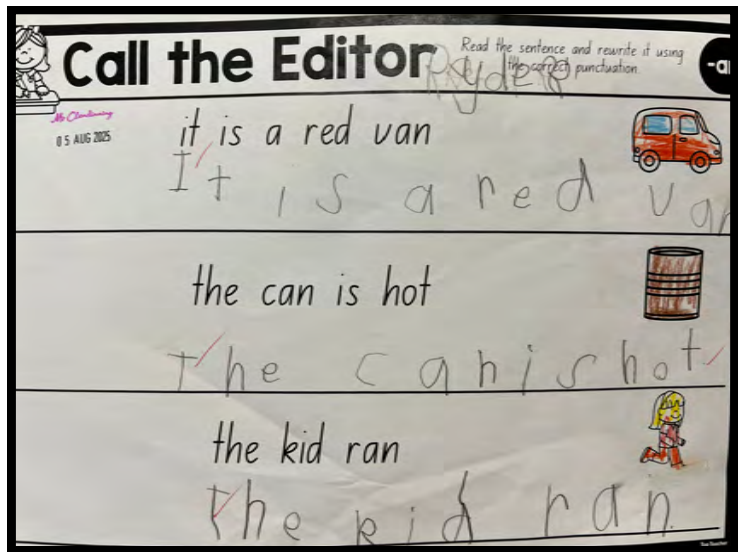


WONDERFUL WORK

Violet

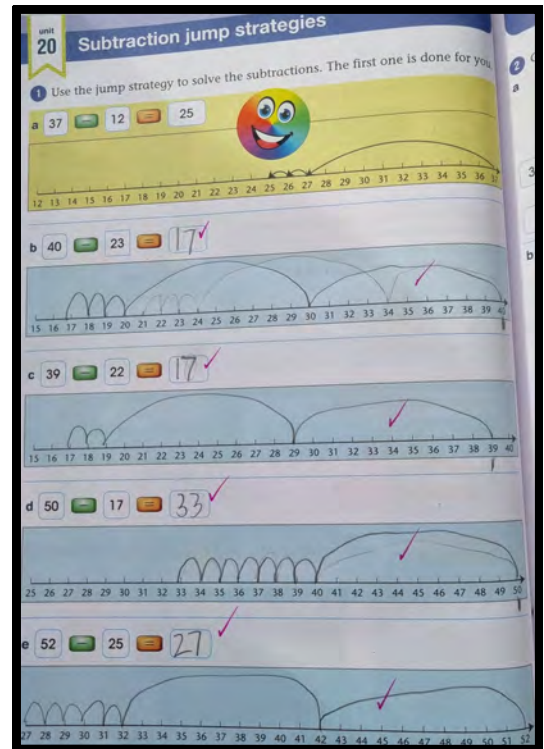

Sarah

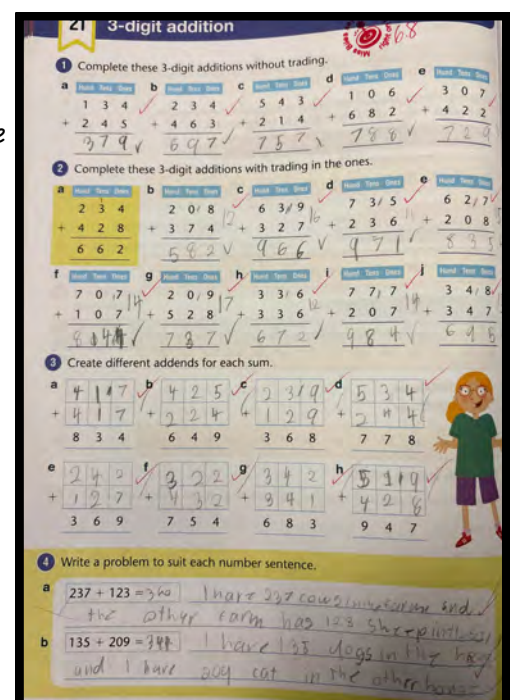

Hannah

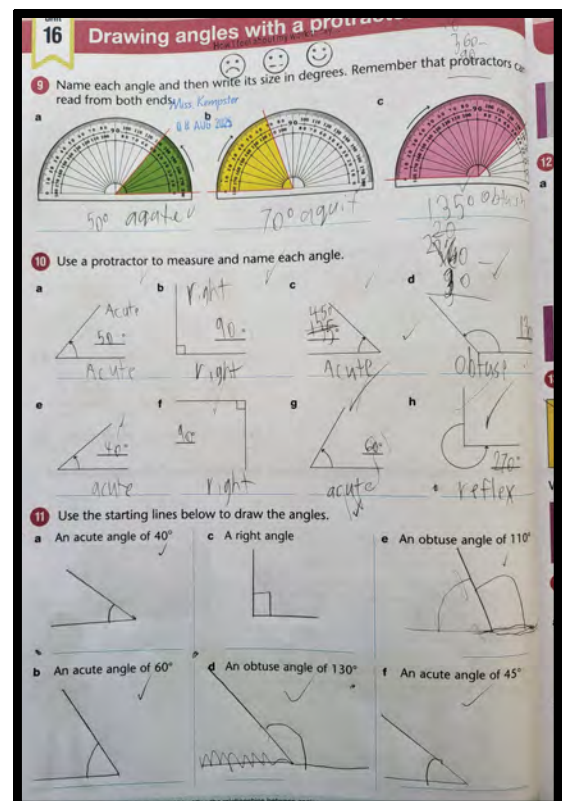
Stage 2 created vibrant platypus artworks using watercolour and oil pastels, linking to our Geography topic on Australia. Great work Hannah!
