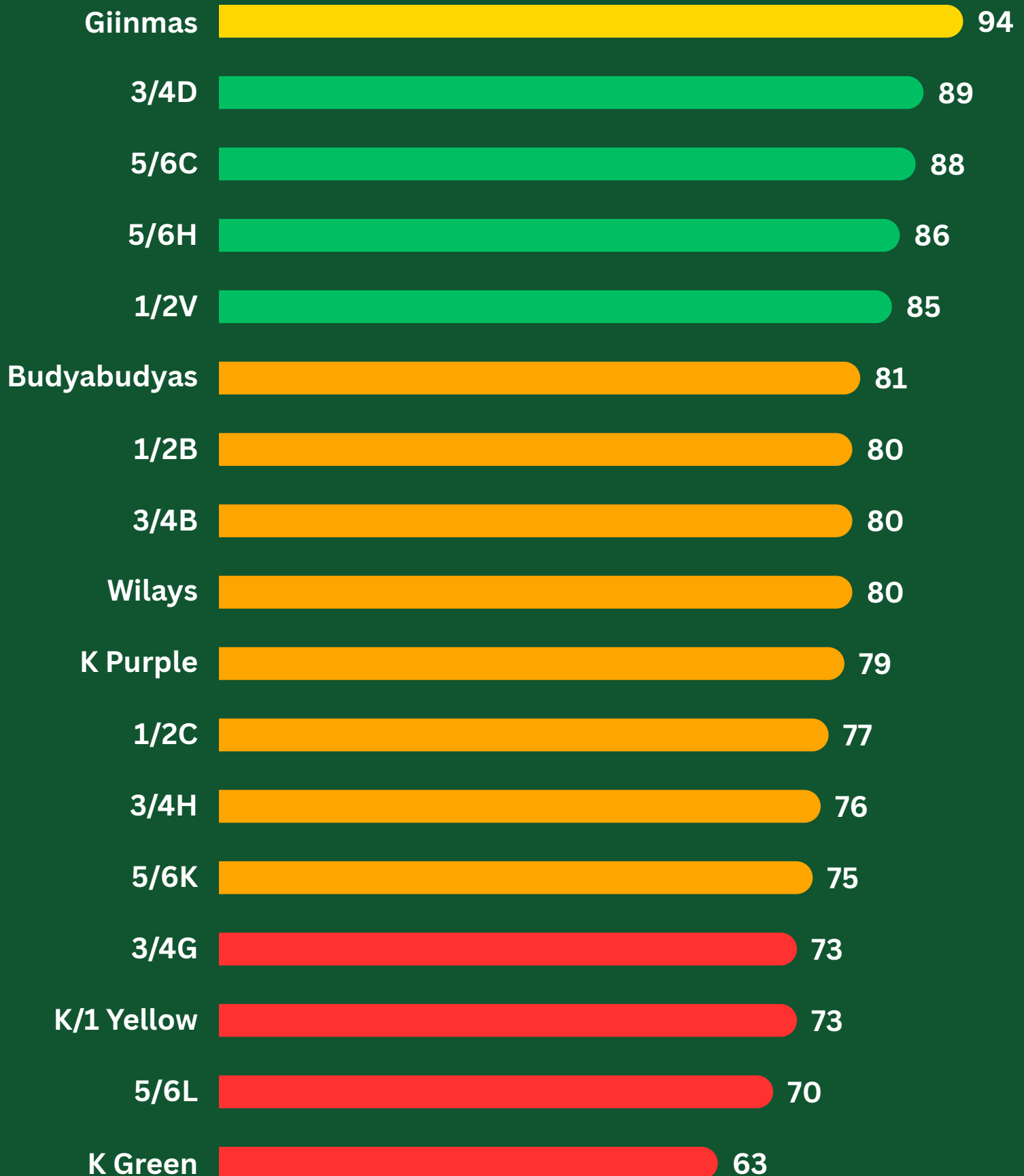

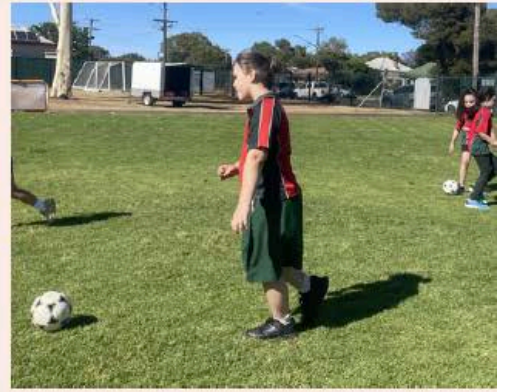


1/2V MORIARTY SESSIONS
