The impossible quiche SRC Friday Lunches

The Impossible quiche recipe



Ingredients:

125g ham, chopped
1 small onion, finely chopped
1 1/2 grated tasty cheese
1/3 cup self raising flour
Salt & pepper, to season
4 eggs
1 1/2 cups milk

Method:

Preheat oven to 200°C. Grease a 5 cup capacity pie dish.

Combine ham, onion, cheese, flour, salt and pepper in a medium bowl. Scatter over base of dish.

Wisk eggs and milk together and pour over the ham mixture. Cook for approx. 40 minutes until puffed and golden.
