Reminder: Please Do Not Park in the Bus Zone or Near the Driveway

We would like to remind all community members to avoid parking in the bus zone or near the school carpark driveway. Last week, a vehicle was parked partially over the driveway, with several others parked close to its entrance and exit. This created a serious safety concern, as visibility was significantly obstructed for drivers exiting the school grounds. Fortunately, no accident occurred, but the situation highlighted the potential danger. Please ensure that you park only in designated areas to help keep our students, staff, and community safe.

Mobiles Phones

Of late, there have been several incidents involving the inappropriate use of mobile phones and social media, including students wearing headphones and AirPods, which have caused concern within our school community. As a reminder, Chifley College Dunheved Campus supports the restrictions of mobile phones in accordance with the NSW Department of Education: Students' Use of Mobile Phones in Schools Policy (<https://education.nsw.gov.au/policy-library/policies/pd-2023-0480>), introduced at the beginning of Term 4, 2023, which states that **students are NOT allowed to use mobile phones, headphones, earphones and airpods at school, including during recess and lunch.**



Parents and carers can assist the school in enforcing this policy by not participating in any mobile phone communications with your child during school hours. If you need to get a message to your child, please do so via the front office. In addition, we kindly ask for your cooperation in monitoring your child's mobile phone and social media use. Together, we can foster a positive community where all students feel secure and respected.

A friendly reminder that our annual Multicultural Day will be on Friday, 14th November 2025, celebrating the rich diversity within our school community through cultural performances, a concert, and a special luncheon for staff and students.
