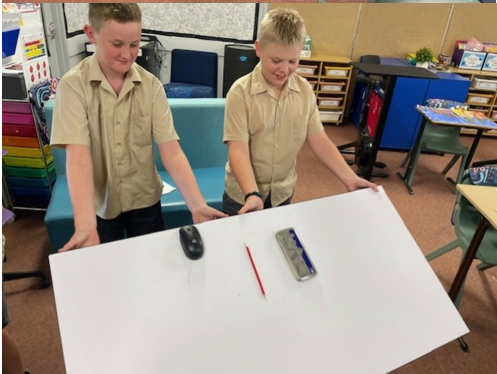


Senior Class News

Curriculum Policy Monitoring

This year our school will undertake Curriculum Policy Monitoring (CPM). Schools prepare a submission outlining how they comply and then have a meeting explaining their internal processes and policies.
