Smoking at the Bus Stop

Advice from Health NSW is as follows.

Section 6A of the Smoke-free Environment Act 2000 makes a number of outdoor public places smoke-free. Smoking is banned at all public transport stops and stations in NSW. This includes:

- platforms of passenger railways/light rail stations
- bus stops
- taxi ranks
- ferry wharves
- light rail stops

The ban applies regardless of whether the area is covered or uncovered. The ban also applies to the area where people queue or gather.

Smoking is prohibited at school bus stops in New South Wales (NSW) and other areas, including within 4 meters of pedestrian entrances to public buildings and near children's play equipment.

The smoke-free laws also apply to the use of e-cigarettes (vaping).
