As I write this, we have passed the mid point of a busy and successful Term 3 with much to celebrate. Looking back through the schools Facebook feed we can reflect on some of the great activities and achievements of the term and recognise the unique and diverse talents of our students.

This term, we received the Year 3 and Year 5 NAPLAN results. While there were a variety of outcomes to both celebrate and use to inform our future focus areas, we are proud to share that the growth rate of our Year 5 students at Ellalong, compared to students across the State, is outstanding. Specifically, from Year 3 to Year 5, our students' growth in Reading exceeded the State average by 9.2%, in Numeracy by an impressive 31.95%, and in Writing, our growth surpassed the State average by an exceptional 43.64%.

Congratulations to Marlie C who was asked to perform the Acknowledgement of Country at the Kullaburra Awards. This event recognised the attendance and achievements of Aboriginal students in the local Aboriginal Education Consultative Group. Marlie was also presented with a 'Sports Award', Braxsen A was also presented with an 'All Rounder' award, while Bronte B, Delilah G, Skylah F and two others received awards for excellent attendance. Congratulations to these students!
