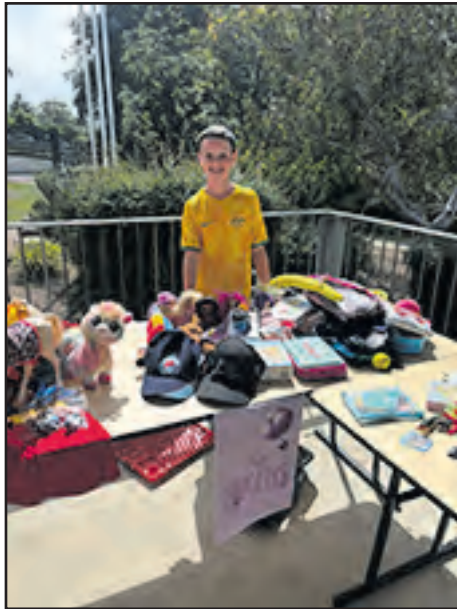
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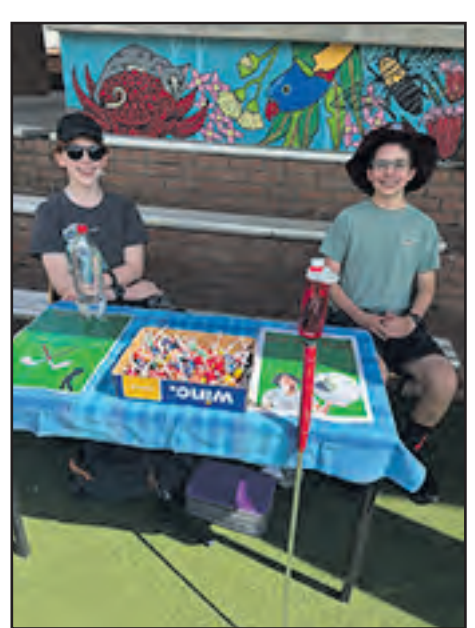
SUMMER GAMES

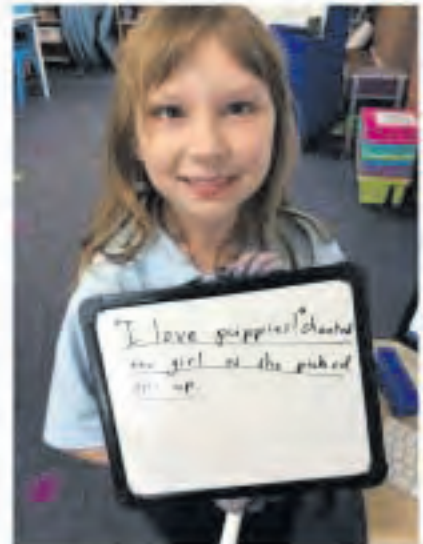
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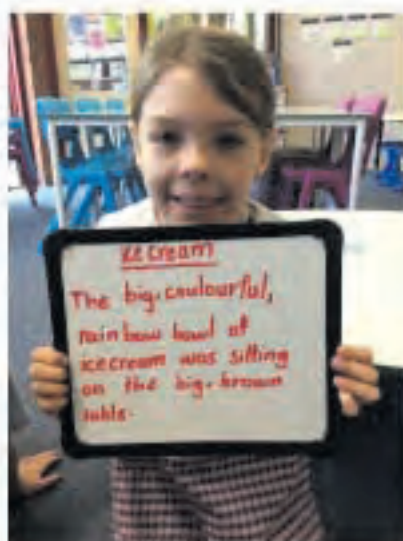




2/3 Barrugin

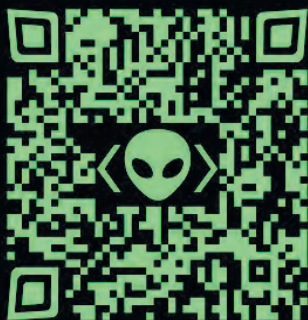
