School Uniform Guidelines

Students at Engadine West Public School are proud to wear their uniform, which indicates they are students of this school. The uniform guidelines are established through the collaboration of the P&C and school. It is part of the school's discipline policy that all students wear school uniform.

In 2023 a school/P&C uniform committee undertook extensive community consultation to:

- modernise and create a cohesive colour palette which is low in cost for families
- reduce the number of uniform items
- provide a gender-neutral option
- respect the heritage and the school community.

From 2024 there is a three year changeover period to wearing the full new school uniform. This changeover period will finish at the end of the 2026 school year. In 2027 all students are expected to wear the new school uniform.

- The green school hat plays an important part in providing sun protection when the students go outside to play and do sport. All students are expected to wear their school hat everyday throughout the year. The school has a no-hat no-play policy.
- We do not encourage the wearing of jewellery. Sleeper earrings or studs may be worn if your child has pierced ears. No other jewellery should be worn due to the risk of accidents.
- Make-up is not allowed unless requested for a specific performance.
- Year 6 students may wear their Year 6 shirts Monday to Thursday.
- School PSSA uniforms remain the property of the school. They will be cleaned and returned to PSSA coaches at the conclusion of competition.
- Please label all items of clothing, as well as school bags, lunch boxes, drink bottles and library bags.
