Hello Parents and Carers

Welcome to all our wonderful families, new and 'old'. If your child is returning to our school, you already know what a fabulous place it is because our families and staff are what make it fabulous. If you are new to our school, welcome! We are thrilled to have you join our EPS family.

This year we welcome Mrs Kath Kennedy (4K) and Miss Zoe Pardey (1P). We are also excited to add Mrs Anna Brown and Mrs Danielle Withford to our RFF teaching staff. Miss Alicia Kelly will return part time while Mrs Richards will take maternity leave, later in this semester. Mr Boutland returns as a married man and Mrs Zammit as a grandmother.

All public schools in NSW have been supplied with a QR code for visitors on school grounds. They have been copied and placed for your convenience, should you need to visit the school office. Masks are preferred for entry to the office please. Parents of younger students (K – 2 only) are permitted to bring their child into school grounds until Friday 5 February, providing they log in via the QR code. This is great news as we navigate our way safely into 2021, COVID style. The new K-2 covered area outside the canteen has been designated the place for K-2 drop offs. In the afternoons, *all children* (except Kindergarten) will exit the school through the gate chosen by yourself, where you will be able to meet your child without needing to enter and log in. Kindergarten teachers will take Kindergarten children to their gate at 2.30pm, for pick up. KS and KT Kindergarten children will exit via the Karingi Street gate and KL and KZ will exit via the Uligandi Street gate. Kindergarten will, for the first two weeks until Fri Feb 12, finish their school day at 2.30pm.

Last Wednesday, staff returned to school to complete two days of mandatory professional learning in addition to the professional development required to continue their teacher registration, which must be renewed and paid, annually. At the end of this year, there will only be one Staff Development Day instead of the two we had in previous years. Having them at the beginning of the year is much more productive, in my opinion.

Teachers are very keen to improve all results and achievements but good literacy skills are vital to function in today's ever changing world. We can get by without knowing some things because we can always research the information we need but if we cannot read or comprehend properly, then we are at risk of missing out on opportunities or being duped by unscrupulous individuals who seek to profit from those less literate. This year, we have established two classes in an effort to further improve the achievements of our students. These classes, in Stages One and Two, will have a smaller number of students and are called our Aspire classes. I encourage everyone to set ten minutes aside each afternoon or evening for their child to read. You may be surprised at the difference this small amount of time each day will make to your child's future. While schools have two weeks to form classes, our students were placed in their new classes today, after recess.

Teachers will soon send home information about your child's class but, in general, all students will be required to purchase a designated maths text book; students in Years K – 2 have most items supplied in their room; and students in Years 3 - 6 will need a sensibly stocked pencil case. I say sensibly because some pencil cases are so big and full they could supply the whole class! Don't forget to label clearly, everything that your child brings to school, including and especially, lunch boxes, drink bottles, school jackets and hats, please.
