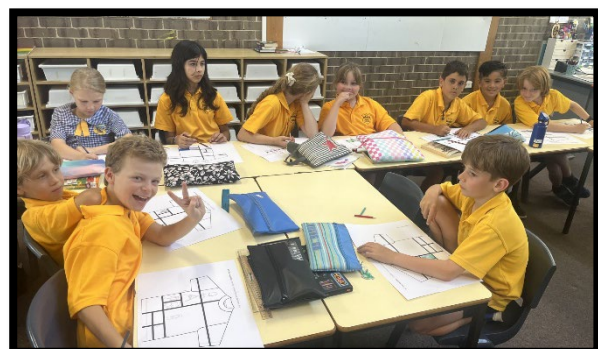
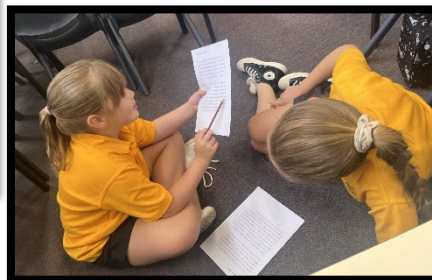
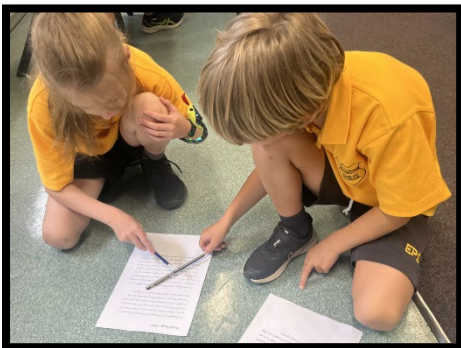

4R have had a wonderful start to the year and are adapting to the delivery of the new curriculum well. Our English sessions consist of a range of activities, including partner fluency, spelling, writing, and discussing our recently completed novel, The Thing About Oliver. The novel has allowed for great discussion about inclusion, resilience and empathy. Next week, we will begin our unit on Genre, which focuses on a combination of fiction and non-fiction texts about Earth and the Solar System.

In mathematics, we have been learning about the number system including infinitely small and large numbers and using a variety of strategies to solve addition and subtraction problems. This fortnight, we will be focusing on determining units of measurement.

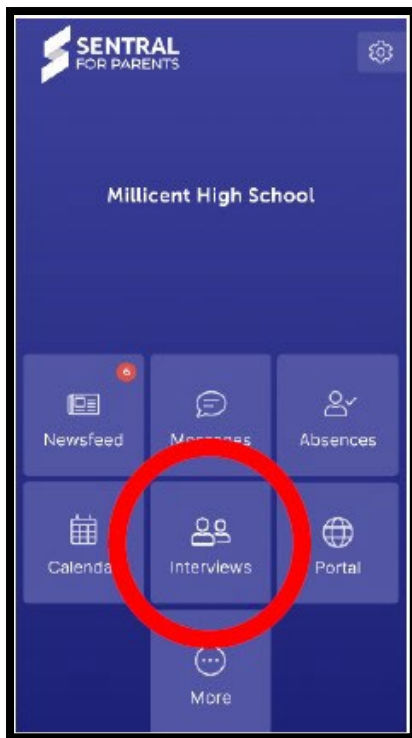
### Parent Teacher Interview Bookings
