All medication provided by parents/carers needs to be provided in original packaging or Webster packs and clearly labelled by the pharmacy with;

1. Students full name
2. Name of medication
3. Medication dose
4. Time for administration
5. Instructions for administration

New medication should be taken at home for 24 hours under observation in case of side effects. Any reactions must be reported to the school. Students must not carry medications, prescribed or unsubscribed. Parents/carers are to bring the medication to the office and provide it to the office staff.

REPEAT: On Tuesday 26 March, we will be holding Parent/Teacher Interviews here at school from 3-6pm. We encourage all families to come along to discuss your child's progress so far this year.
