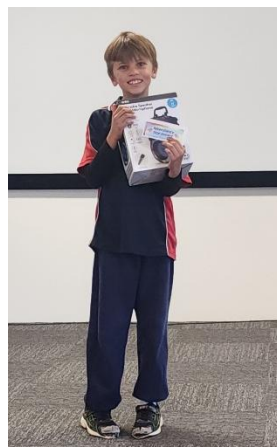

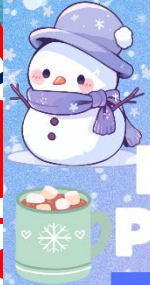

Online Parenting Group

Online parenting groups are for parents & carers
who would like to:

- Understand their child's emotional world by
learning to read their emotional needs.
- Support their child's ability to successfully
manage emotions.
- Improve communication and strengthen the
bond with their child.
- Better understand their child's behaviour and
learn new parenting approaches.



We are offering two programs: Circle of Security and Tuning in to Kids.

What is Circle of Security?
The Circle of Security (COS) Parenting™ program is based on decades of research about how secure parent-
child relationships can be supported and strengthened. It is best suited for parent/careers of children aged 5 &
yrs although can be beneficial for all parent/careers.

What is Tuning in to Kids?
Tuning in to Kids (TIK) is an evidenced based, emotion-focused parenting course that supports
Parents & carers to recognise, understand and manage their own and their children's emotions. It is best
suited for parent/careers of children aged 5-12 yrs.

Who is it for?
We are delivering TIK & COS as part of our Community Recovery Service
which covers the following LGAs in NSW: Cabonne,
Cootamundra-Gundagai, Dubbo, Forbes, Gundagai, Snowy Valleys,
Glen Innes, Severn and Snowy Monaro.

Where?
Groups will take place online via Zoom. Access to stable internet,
a computer/device, and a private space will be required.

When?
Pending numbers, we usually offer a group each school term.
