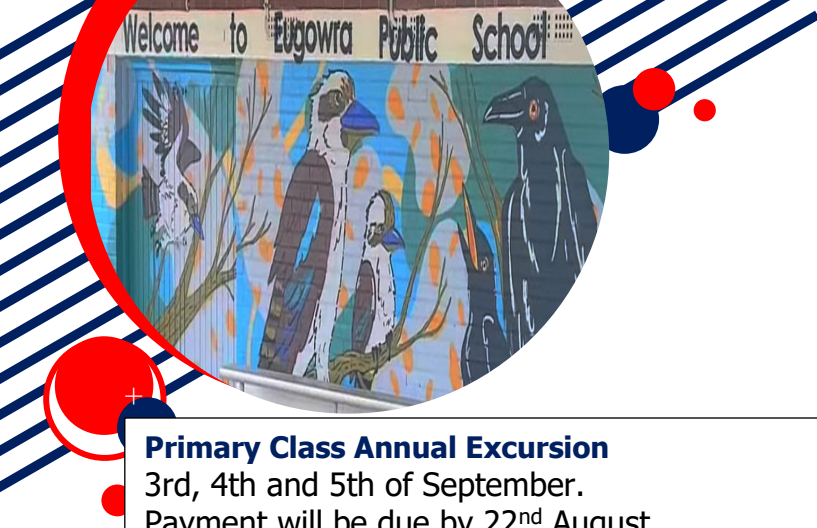

External Validation

At the end of Term 2, our school completed External Validation. This involved staff reflecting on our school practices and processes and assessing against each of the elements within the School Excellence Framework using the descriptors of quality practice. The school then submitted evidence for our judgements and engaged with an external panel to have our self-assessments validated.

Our school is very proud to inform our parent community that our school achieved the highest level 'Excelling' in seven of the fourteen elements: Learning Culture, Wellbeing, Effective Classroom Practice, Learning & Development, Educational Leadership, School Resources, and Management Practices & Processes. And 'Sustaining and Growing' the second highest level for 5 of the elements: Curriculum, Assessment, Data Skills & Use, Professional Standards, and School Planning, Implementation & Reporting. We received the recommended level of Delivering for 2 of the elements: Reporting, and Student Growth & Performance.

Ideas to add more vegetables
