Visual Arts
Year 7 Visual Arts students are creatively making spooky Ceramic Monster Pots. 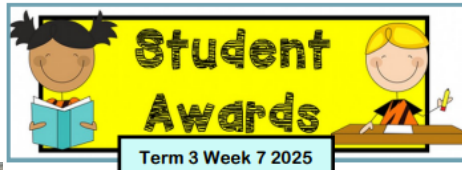
