Thank you to our amazing parents who came to Open Day and spent time in their child's classroom and watched the book parade.


We value your support and were very happy to welcome you into our school.

We are enrolling for Kindergarten 2026

Any child turning 5 years of age before the 31st July 2026 can start Kindergarten at the beginning of 2026.



(children born between 1st August 2020 and 31 July 2021)

Children in NSW must be enrolled in primary school by their sixth birthday.
