2025 School Photo Day! Wednesday, 19 March 2025

Next week, each child will receive a photo order envelope. Students are required to return their envelopes on School photo day even **if they are not ordering photos**. Please **DO NOT** send your child's individual envelope to school before photo day.

Payment can be made online or by enclosing the correct money as no change can be given.

A Sibling envelope will be sent home with the eldest child if they have a brother or sister attending FPS. **Sibling** photos will only be available for **students attending our school**. To enable us to plan for sibling photos, envelopes must be returned to the front office **before** photo day if you choose to have a sibling photo taken.

We ask students to wear their full summer uniform.

Girls in Summer tunic, white socks and black shoes. Boys in Navy and Gold polo shirts, grey shorts, grey socks and black shoes.

HELPFUL INFORMATION For Parents and Carers

Change of Routine

If your child has a change of routine a note must be sent to the class teacher that morning.

Sometimes changes are unavoidable and parents need to ring the office. If possible all messages should be phoned in by 2.00pm to ensure your child receives the message.

Please do not send change of routine through the school email as these can sometimes be missed.

Money

Money that is sent to school for visiting shows, sport, excursions etc. needs to be in a sealed envelope or snap lock bag with child's name, class and what it is for.

Visiting shows must be paid as early as possible to avoid your child missing out. Pre payment accounts will be invoiced shortly.

Appointments

Parents wishing to speak to teachers must make an appointment either by phoning the office or by contacting your child's class teacher via their preferred method of communication.

Property

Please label all clothing and property with your child's name. The school endeavours to return all lost property to its rightful owner.

Toys and valued items are not the responsibility of the school and are not encouraged.

Early Arrivals

Students should not arrive at school before 8.30am. A teacher on duty will open the entrance gate at this time.

Late Arrivals

Students arriving late to school must be signed in through the office by a **parent or carer**. A note will be printed for the classroom teacher.

Permission Notes

Permission notes for Town Excursions, Medical Information and Permission to use Photographs were sent home last week. Please return these notes to your child's class teacher as soon as possible.

Pick Ups

All students in Years K—6 are picked up through the main entrance. The gates will be opened at 3pm when a staff member is on duty.

Student Absences

Forbes Public School, like all DEC schools is required to record partial and full absences for all students.

Please ensure if your child is away an explanation is sent through as soon as possible. The Sentral for Parent Portal app will help with this process. Absence explanations may also be emailed to your child's class teacher or phoned through the front office.

If you need to take additional holiday time during the school year, the Department of Education requires students to complete an application for extended leave. These forms are held in the office and need to be completed and returned to school for approval before you leave. Please contact the office if you need one.

WWCC for Volunteers

As part of the processes involved in supporting students across our school, Parents and Carers who assist in any way are required to complete the Working With Children's Check (WWCC) for Volunteers.

The WWCC can be completed online and then finalised at a Service NSW registry. A WWCC number is then generated and we ask you to please bring this into the office for our records.

RFW are coming to visit Forbes Public School

Allied Health Clinicians from Royal Far West (RFW) will be visiting our school between Monday 17th – Friday 22nd February.

RFW will be supporting the School throughout 2025 and 2026 with their Community Recovery Program.



How can RFW help?

During the visit, RFW will introduce its services and engage with students and parents/carers interested in accessing support. Clinicians will spend time in classrooms and meet with parents/carers. **RFW services are FREE** for children and parents. Some of the services which will be offered ongoing:

- <u>Support for children</u>: Free individual online tele-therapy for children with specific needs (Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy, Psychology).
- Support for school staff: Professional Learning sessions on topics of interest.
- Support for parents/carers: Free tailored parenting support from a social worker & access to online parenting groups (Tuning in to Kids & Circle of Security).
