In the Bin! is coming...



EnviroMentors is the leading mobile education provider run by Keep Australia Beautiful NSW and trusted by schools and teachers across NSW since 1994. Over 4 days the entire cohort at Forster Public School is participating in the In the Bin Program. This module focuses on what goes in which bin. Students learn the appropriate and safe bin to place waste in, and what happens to it, depending on where it goes – to landfill, a recycling centre, or to be turned into compost. Tricky waste like e-waste and fast fashion are discussed, emphasising the importance of diverting waste from landfill.

Urgent matters require an action or response

- · changes to arrangements that need to be communicated to your student
- · your student's health and wellbeing.

Non-urgent matters

Including:

- · requesting a meeting with our school staff
- · requesting information about an upcoming school
- · providing brief information to the school
- raising a concern.

What you can expect

If necessary, you will need to leave a message with our office staff who will identify the best person to respond to your call, if needed. The response will happen by the end of the next school day.
