

### WE ARE A CHILD CARE SUBSIDY APPROVED PROVIDER

Individual Child Care Subsidy (CCS) entitlements are determin based on your family's circumstances.

Families earning a combined income of less than \$335,000 are eligible to receive a Child Care Subsidy on their child care fees. Centrelink will also determine the number of care hours per fortnight that your CCS percentage can be applied to based on an activity test. If you exceed these hours full fees will be applied.
