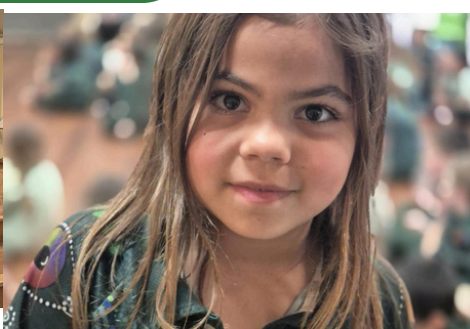


Family game of the week!

Check in!

The Check In Assessment will be on for the next 2 weeks and it will assess Reading and Numeracy for kids in Year 3 - 6 and writing for Year 6. We already know our kids are clever and it gives us an opportunity to see what they can do in an online environment.

The Check-in Scout reports allow teachers to identify strengths and areas of focus for students either at a cohort or individual level. Each question is mapped to syllabus outcomes, learning progressions and teaching strategies. Schools can usually access this data within 2 school days after finalising the assessments. Wow, we can't wait to see how they go!
