
Vision Screening

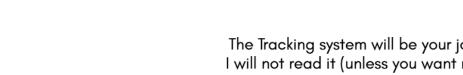
