3. Reports

- + Principals Report (KS)
 - Staff Development Day 1 and 2 were successful and covered English and Maths respectively. English structure is different this year which has been released from the DoE.
 - Teachers are looking for the right way to apply the programmes to the children and looking at further modifications where necessary to ensure the children are appropriately stretched and supported.
 - Our KS1 teachers worked together to identify times where teachers could carve out time that would see teachers go into classrooms and see how existing teachers were putting these new structures into practice. KS would like to put in place information sharing going forward as a lessons learnt.
 - Team planning days have moved teams forward and consolidated their knowledge of the new curriculum and sample units.
 - Meet the teacher, great connection with teachers and parents, thank you to those that attended.
 - Sport district team trials have commenced. George Fasher (GF) asked how families could know when trials commence. KS – advised that this would be through Mrs Noble. Information is shared with senior students and Year 4, however teachers usually know which sport children play and they ask them directly or ask around if need be to gauge interest.
 - Marina Olsen (MO) – asked if there is a reason why it is not published so all parents know. KS advised that the time frame is usually quite short.
 - PSSA trials for summer sports are continuing. Thanks to those involved.
 - Year 3-6 sport started two weeks ago and has been very smooth. Great range of options for kids involved.
 - School comms manager is stepping down. Week at a glance will move to SZAPP. The school website will need to be maintained therefore looking for replacement and funds are available to support this role.

- Class structure for 2024. Stage 3 started on day 1 for students. Year 1 – 4 required review and approval from DEL due to confirmation of complex student enrolments numbers of Days 1 and 2.
 - MO queries whether this was because new families join over the holidays. KS confirmed that yes and they joined classes where numbers were already high. However the good news is that there are no cross stage classes.
 - Kindy (40 students) have started well and best start was valuable.
 - All classes are settled and teams are planning demonstration lessons within their grades for Term 1 to share expertise in specific areas of teaching. It is invaluable and building a “school culture together is a priority in 2024”.
 - Sarah Weir queried why homework was delayed until after Meet the Teacher. KS confirmed it shouldn’t and will raise it with teachers.
- + President’s Report (SV)
- Acknowledging and thank you to those involved in 2023 across all activities.
 - I was a priority to increase joy in the school and with 2 extraordinarily successful events - The Big Day Out and Casino Royale - we did exactly that. As well as many other events.
 - The P&C made monetary donations towards new technology, year 6 jerseys and PSSA jerseys, a portable PA system for the teachers, the ever popular ice cream van on picnic day, staff gifts and staff dinner.

 - o Updating the Hall with DoE Assets on board
 - o Adult and family fundraisers to bring our community together and raise money for the school
 - o Working with the Cottage to ensure its survival as a not for profit organisation that benefits our school

 - o Bank balance remains materially unchanged with minimal spend over the holidays, sandpit cover was required.

 - o 127k committee spend so far as per agenda and minutes.
