A FEW UPDATES...

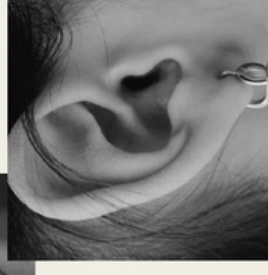
- It was wonderful to see so many families at our recent term Assembly - we love showing off our talented students and the community feel just tops it off! Thank you!

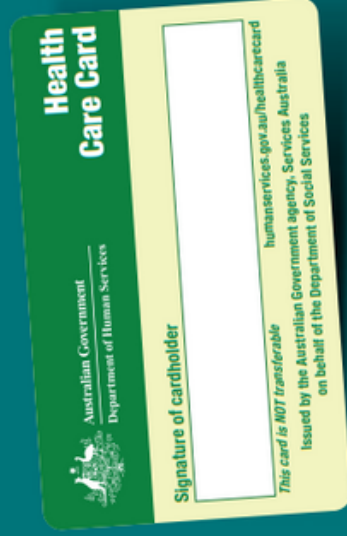
