Session 7 - Standing together

Our Peer Support session in Stronger Together this week looks at the impact of how working together as a team with similar beliefs can provide a barrier to bullying. When everyone is focused on promoting positive behaviours that respect diversity and individual needs, bullying can be reduced. Activities focusing on building teams' strength and awareness of bystanders' responsibilities assist in a whole school approach. Parents and carers could talk with their child about how they could help others who are not experiencing good relationships.

Session 8 -Take the lead

The final session in our Stronger Together Peer Support module summarises skills learnt in previous sessions and provides an opportunity to plan to implement further initiatives across the school. Students will be able to identify personal and whole school goals to further address bullying and build their own resilience. Ask your child what they have learnt and what else they would like to learn about having good relationships. Contact us with your ideas.
