Student Absences

The school must be notified if your child will be away



It is important to let the school know when your child will be away and why your child is absent. Parents can notify the school of their child's absence by:

- Submitting an absence through the School Bytes Parent Portal (preferred method)
- Ringing the school on the morning of each day's absence

Please **DO NOT** submit absences via email or Seesaw.

Extended absence due to travel or illness

If your child will be absent for a holiday of five days or more during the school term, an Application for Extended Leave (Travel) must be completed PRIOR to leave being taken for approval to be considered; otherwise, the absences will be marked as unjustified.

This form can be completed on the School Bytes Parent Portal under the 'Forms' tab.


If your child visits a doctor due to illness, please request a Medical Certificate covering the date(s) of the absence(s). Extended absences due to illness may be eligible for an *Exemption from School* if a Doctor's Certificate is provided for the entire period.

Spooky STEM Fun for Stage 2!

Stage 2 students recently enjoyed two exciting spooky STEM activities that brought science and creativity together. In the “Dancing Ghosts” activity, students generated static electricity using balloons to make tissue paper ghosts dance mysteriously. Then, they tackled the “Bone Bridge” challenge, using cotton tips and sticky tape to build a sturdy bridge capable of holding a small skeleton.

Lots of fun was had as students worked collaboratively, applying important teamwork and STEM skills throughout the activities. They developed their understanding of physical science concepts such as static electricity, explored engineering principles in designing and constructing a functional bridge, and honed critical thinking and problem-solving skills by testing and improving their designs. Communication and cooperation were key as they shared ideas and worked together. Well done Stage 2!
