### Sentral

Parents and carers—please check the Sentral for Parents app regularly. Turn on notifications so you don't miss school news, events or permission notes. Absences should be recorded in Sentral on the day (or within 7 days). If you need help with the app, please contact the office.

### Attendance Matters – Every day counts

Consistent attendance has a big impact on learning and wellbeing.

Every day counts—regular attendance builds strong habits. Be on time - learning starts promptly each morning. Report absences promptly—log reasons in Sentral the same day (or within 7 days).
