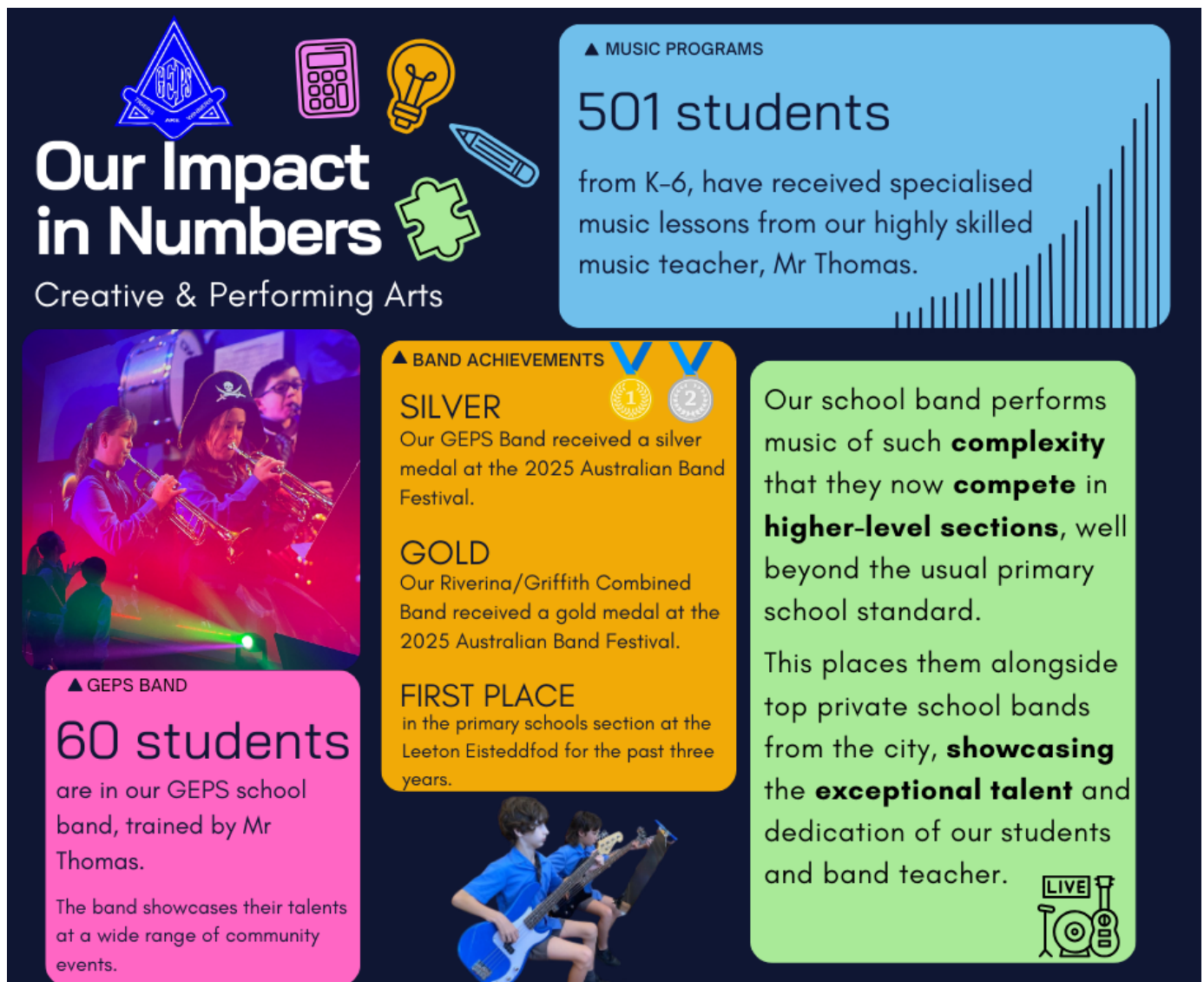


# SRC FOOTY COLOURS DAY & DISCO
