School Swimming & Water Safety Program

All students from Kindergarten to Year 6 will participate in intensive swimming lessons at Kendall Community Pool from Monday 24 November to Friday 28 November.

The School Swimming and Water Safety Program is a government initiative designed to teach children essential swimming skills and water safety knowledge, helping to keep them safe around water and build their confidence.

A bus has been chartered to transport students to and from the pool each day during regular school hours. Therefore, parents and carers will not be required to assist with transport or drop their children off early this year.

The school has received a Sporting Schools grant through the Australian Sports Commission to help subsidise costs associated with the program for families. Final details of the subsidy will be confirmed shortly, and parents and carers will be provided with full information about the program, including the cost per student.

Ask your children which one they chose! We got stuck in and read the info, then voted. Winner announced 7 November. Last year's winner was the blue-banded bee.






