# School Swimming & Water Safety Program

We are pleased to announce that the cost to families for the 2025 School Swimming & Water Safety Program has now been finalised.

Thanks to generous subsidies, the daily bus transport and pool entry fees for the 5-day program are partially covered as follows:


- Sporting Schools Grant: \$25 per student
- School-funded subsidy: \$25 per student
- P&C subsidy: \$50 per student

These subsidies reduce the final cost to families to just **\$30 per student**.

An activity will be created in Sentral shortly, along with the \$30 per student fee for payment.
