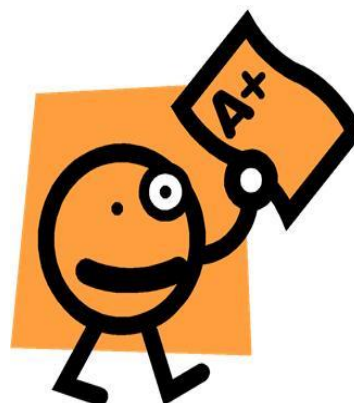

Booking Parent Teacher Interviews on



1. Log into the Parent Portal and select the **Interview Tab**.
2. Click on **Select Timeslots** to see available times.
3. You will see a list of your child's teachers and their available times.
4. Select your preferred times for each interview.

6. Click the **Save Bookings** button.
