## Pulse Alive 2026 Concert: Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> March

Dear Parents and Carers,

The Pulse Alive concert is going to be a long and exciting day! Tickets have now sold out. Please read through the following information to ensure the day runs smoothly. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact Miss Siniawski through the front office prior to the day.

Our students will be performing as part of the First Nations Dance Ensemble and the Finale. Miss Siniawski, Miss Cuevas and Mr Beale will be supervising the students throughout the day and night. Rehearsal will be held throughout the day at Sydney Olympic Park followed by the nighttime concert.

<b>Date:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> March 2026.</li></ul>
<b>Venue:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Ken Rosewall Arena, Sydney Olympic Park.</li></ul>
<b>Bring:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Bag, recess, dinner, water.</li><li>\$25 for lunch at McDonalds or a packed lunch.</li></ul>
<b>Wear:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Orange Pulse Alive shirt provided to students in the few days before the concert.</li><li>Full length black pants or leggings.</li><li>White socks and white shoes with white soles. Shoes that have some colour on them but are mostly white are fine. White shoes are available at Kmart.</li><li>Students with long hair are encouraged to wear it in a half up / half down bun or ponytail. See example picture below:</li></ul> 
<b>Arrival:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Students are to meet at Yalingen Allawah hall at 8.45am.</li><li>The bus to Olympic Park will leave school at 9.00am.</li></ul>
<b>Dismissal:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><b>For parents not attending the concert:</b> Students will return to school by bus at approximately 10.40pm. They will need to be picked up by a parent/carer from the top gate near Yalingen Allawah.</li><li><b>For parents attending the concert:</b> Students can be collected at 10.00pm at the "H flag" on the corner of Olympic Boulevard and Shirley Strickland Avenue. 

## **Pulse Alive Performance Day Plan**

<b>8.45am</b>	Students meet at Yalingen Allawah.
<b>9.00am</b>	Bus leaves school.
<b>9.30am</b>	Arrive at Sydney Olympic Park. Walk to Ken Rosewall Arena to check in.
<b>10.30am</b>	First Nations Dance Ensemble rehearsal.
<b>11.30am</b>	Recess break at the arena – students eat food brought from home.
<b>12.00pm</b>	Walk to Cathy Freeman Park for teacher led games.
<b>1.30pm</b>	First Nations Dance practise as a school.
<b>2.00pm</b>	McDonalds for lunch.
<b>3.00pm</b>	Walk back to Ken Rosewall Arena.
<b>3.40pm</b>	Seated for Finale rehearsal.
<b>4.00pm</b>	Finale rehearsal.
<b>5.00pm</b>	Dinner break at the arena – students eat food brought from home.
<b>6.45pm</b>	Students move to arena seats, ready for the performance.
<b>7.10pm</b>	Students move to the marshalling area.
<b>7.30pm</b>	Performance begins.
<b>8.40pm</b>	Performance interval.
<b>9.00pm</b>	Performance resumes.
<b>9.55pm</b>	Performance ends.
<b>10.00pm</b>	Meet parents/carers who attend the concert at the “H flag” on the corner of Olympic Boulevard and Shirley Strickland Avenue. See map attached.  Students who are not picked up at the “H flag” will get on the bus with teachers and make their way back to Hebersham Public School.
<b>10.40pm</b>	Arrive back at school at the top gate. Students must be picked up by a parent/carers.

## Pickup Flags

Following the performance, large teardrop banners with letters of the alphabet will be placed as per this map.

Parents should go to the letter corresponding with the first letter of their students' school to meet students and teachers at the end of the performance.

See the yellow arrow pointing at the 'H flag'.



## Road Closures

Road closures will be in place on performance days from 6:00 pm – 10:30 pm as indicated on this map.

It will NOT be possible for cars or buses to drop off or pick up directly from Olympic Boulevard (south of Sarah Durack Avenue) during this time period.

## Parking

If you are driving to the venue, it is a good idea to pre-book parking as it will be very busy on the night.
