

LAUNCH

Students at Hermidale Public School have embarked on an exciting project where they authored and illustrated this book, drawing inspiration from the mentor text "Under the Southern Cross" written by Frane' Lessac.

In this creative endeavouur, Stage 3 students engaged in thorough research to gather interesting facts about our local town, including its rich connection to the Ngiyampaa Wangaaypuwan people. They incorporated words from the Ngiyampaa language, such as "thurumpaal" (milky way) and "marrawuy" (red kangaroo), to enrich their storytelling and highlight the cultural significance of the area. They worked alongside our younger students to publish the story using CANVA.

By combining their artistic talents with their newfound knowledge of the local First Nations heritage, the students not only enhanced their writing and illustration skills but also fostered a deeper understanding and respect for the Ngiyampaa Wangaaypuwan people and their connection to the land.

This project exemplifies the integration of literacy and local studies, encouraging students to take pride in their surroundings while developing their creativity.














BOOK LAUNCH
