We're so proud of you for representing our school so well. Keep up the awesome work, Isabelle and Tyler - you're inspiring all of us!

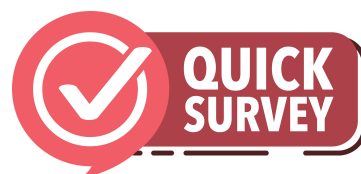


Reminder
