Stay tuned for the first clue in next week's newsletter, and let's make this a fun way to encourage everyone to stay connected!

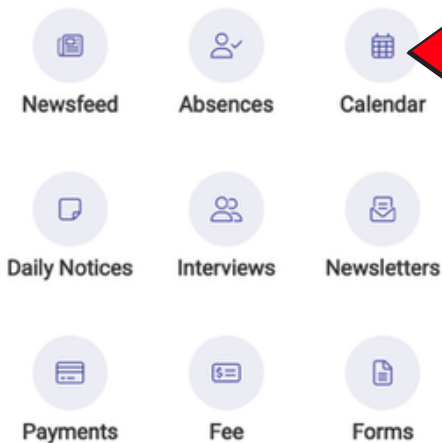
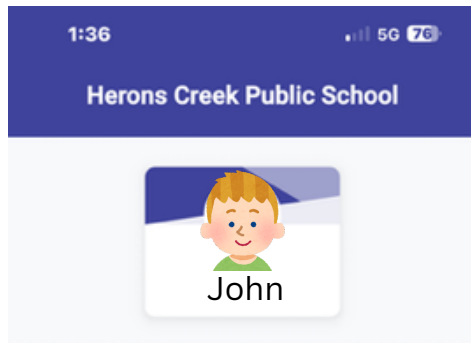




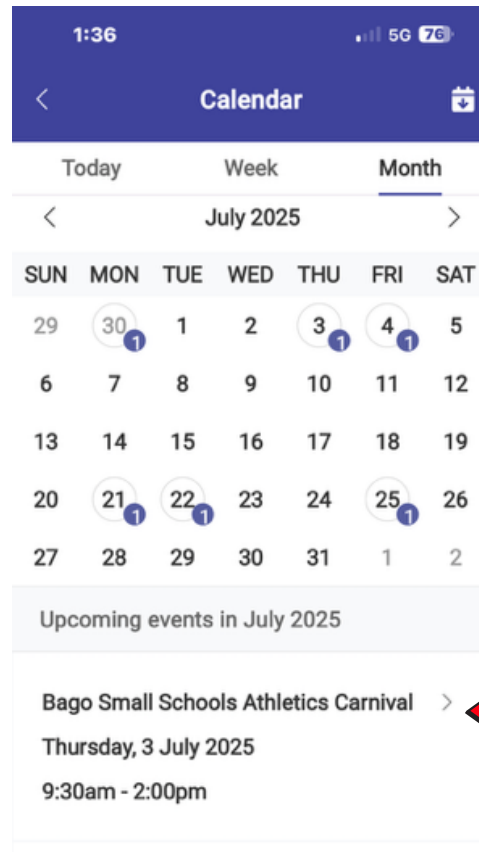

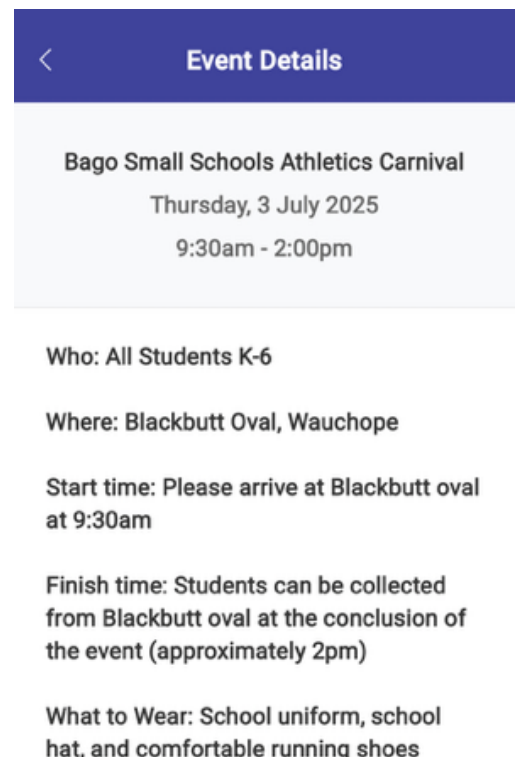
