Online Safety for Kids

We all want our children to be safe when learning and playing online. eSafety Commissioner provides information and tools to parents and carers to help keep children safe online.

Children can learn, explore, play and make friends online. But there can be risks. Your child might accidentally see upsetting content, be contacted by strangers or experience bullying. Here are some easy things you can do to help keep children safe online.

Talk about online safety as a family: Let your child know they can always come to you if something happens online that makes them feel scared or upset.

Set up family rules together: As a family, you can choose some easy rules to help keep everyone safe online. You can include things like where devices can be used, what games and apps your children can use, and how much time can be spent online. Most devices and apps have features to set limits on how they are used.

Know where to get help: If you need help with an online issue and you are not sure what to do, talk about it with someone you trust, like a friend or a teacher at your child's school. You can also speak to someone at 1300 1300 52 | Parent Line NSW for help with parenting challenges.

Important Bushfire Season Notice - Starting 1 October 2025

As we approach the upcoming bushfire season, Herons Creek Public School would like to remind our community of important safety procedures in place.

Herons Creek Public School is classified as a Category 1 school. This means that when the NSW Rural Fire Service (RFS) declares a Catastrophic Fire Danger rating for our area, the Department of Education will direct Category 1 schools to proactively temporarily cease school operations for the following day to ensure the safety of all students and staff.

In the event of an evacuation, our designated off-site evacuation point is Camden Haven High School. Please ensure your family is aware of this location and the procedures that may be followed during a bushfire emergency.

We encourage all families to stay informed by monitoring RFS warnings and communications from the school as the bushfire season progresses. Your safety is our highest priority. Thank you for your cooperation and support in keeping our school community safe.


