Attendance Matters

We encourage our students to attend school every day that they are able to, apart from when they are unwell. When your child is absent it is important you let the school know soon as possible, including the reason why. This helps make sure we know where our students are and can offer support for you and your family if needed. You can notify us of absences via the School Bytes parent portal, a handwritten note, or via the school email. Missing a day here or there may not seem like much, but absences add up and can impact your child's learning and wellbeing. One day per fortnight adds up to 4 weeks of missed learning in one year. Over an entire school journey, this adds up to one year of lost learning.



Raising Healthy Minds

The Raising Healthy Minds app is a free, personalised, pocket resource to help parents and carers raise confident, resilient children. Co-designed with parents and experts and funded by the Australian Government, Raising Healthy Minds aims to support children's social and emotional wellbeing with evidence-based information.
