Details are as follows:

- Travel: Students will be travelling by bus to and from Hayes Park.
- Departure: Students will leave the school at 11:00 AM.
- Junior (years 3 & 4) games start by 11:30 AM.
- Senior (years 5 & 6) games start at 12:20 AM.
- Students will return to school by 2:00 PM.

To ensure a successful and enjoyable experience, please remind your child of the following:

- Uniform: Students are required to wear their sports uniform and a school hat.
- Jewellery: For safety reasons, students are not allowed to wear any jewellery during the games.
- Food and Hydration: Students need to bring their own recess, lunch, and water bottle.
- Sun Protection: Please ensure your child has appropriate sun protection.

We believe this will be a fantastic experience for our students, promoting teamwork, sportsmanship, and physical activity. The emphasis is on sport participation and friendly competition, so as such a points table is not kept.

The cost for the term is \$70 to help cover bus costs. Payment and consent can be given via School Bytes.


