#### **Emergency Management for bus flooding**

Emergency management procedures for buses have been reviewed throughout 2025. The following steps are now in place to ensure student safety:

- Inspections are carried out at key flooding points and council road closures are monitored by the bus company.
- The bus company contacts the school by 7am and 2pm daily.
- The school informs the community about bus operations through SchoolBytes email and Facebook.

All buses for Holgate and Matcham now have live CCTV, allowing continuous monitoring of student safety.

If roads become too dangerous during the bus route and students cannot get home, the bus driver will:

- Contact the depot and a four-wheel drive vehicle will be sent to drop students at their homes. It helps if students know their parents' contact details or have a card with this information in their school bags.
- While waiting, the bus driver will try to contact parents to inform them that safety procedures are in place. Parents may then choose to collect their children.
- If students still cannot get in contact with parents or get students home safely, the bus driver will contact the school and either return students to school or the depot.

The bus company will stay in contact with the school throughout this process. The same procedure applies if trees fall or other emergencies occur. We would like to thank the Holgate Public School community for their calmness and consideration during these situations and for becoming skilled in emergency management.






