

Composite and multistage classes benefits

Many parents and carers have expressed concerns about multi-grade or stage classes since my return to Holgate. Feedback indicates that many worry about the construction of classes such as 1/2/3 or 3/4/5. Most teachers have experienced teaching a straight class and recognise that they can be just as complex as multi-grade or stage classes like ours.

The most important aspect of any class composition is understanding our students academically, socially and emotionally, regardless of the class structure. This understanding equips teachers to effectively use our summative and formative assessment practices and data to differentiate instruction. This differentiation occurs at our school in English and Mathematics. For the other key learning areas, we utilise multi-grade units. Teachers also employ departmental scopes and sequences documents to ensure that syllabus outcomes and content are taught.

Being a small school with these multi-grade or stage classes has so many benefits:

- 1. **Personalised Attention**: Smaller school sizes often mean that all the teachers can give more individualised attention to each student and know all students making them known, valued, cared for.
- 2. **Strong Community**: Small schools tend to foster a close-knit community where students, parents, and teachers know each other well, creating a supportive environment.
- 3. **Increased Participation**: Students in small schools often have more opportunities to participate in various activities, such as sports, music and leadership, which can enhance their school experience.

- 4. **Stronger Relationships**: With fewer students, it's easier for teachers to build strong relationships with their students, which can lead to a more positive and engaging learning environment.
- 5. **Flexible Learning Environments**: Small schools have more flexibility in their curriculum and teaching methods, allowing for innovative approaches to education.
- 6. **Enhanced Communication**: Communication between parents and teachers can be more direct and effective in smaller settings, leading to better collaboration on student progress.
- 7. **Focus on Socio-emotional learning**: Smaller schools emphasise social-emotional learning, helping students develop important life skills.
- 8. **Lower Stress Levels**: The environment in small schools can be less overwhelming for some students, potentially leading to lower stress levels and better mental health.

To order for another child, click "Order for Another Child" and then click "Add Via Child Details" and enter their surname and date of birth. Family/Sibling Photos are also available.

All Family/Sibling orders must be placed by 11pm the day before photo day.

Please note - A late/processing fee will apply for orders received 1 week after photo day.






