



There are three string ensembles at Hornsby South:

1. Chamber Strings on Monday afternoons in the hall
2. Beginner strings on Mondays at 7.50 am in the hall
3. String Ensemble on Wednesdays at 7.50 am in the hall

Students play their choice of violin, viola or cello.

Eligibility: All students K to 6. Absolute beginners welcome. Students must also attend lessons as well as attending string ensemble. The conductor advises which of the three ensembles the student should join.

What is expected: Weekly attendance at string ensemble, weekly lessons, regular practice.
