Q: *Why is my child not with their Home Learning teacher all of the time?*

- A:**
- Consideration has been made for students who may find change of routine challenging.
 - We have aimed to narrow the differentiation required so that the teaching can be more targeted and personalised, better supporting student learning and engagement.
 - The lesson structure is the same across both stage classes. Students are exposed to stage appropriate content but scaffolding and repetition opportunities will be differentiated.



Q: *Why is the school having separate classes for English and mathematics and the other subjects?*

- A:**
- We are prioritising our core skills of English and mathematics.
 - Staffing has been used creatively to allow for students to be divided into 6 classes across Years 1-6 rather than 5.
 - This allows us to keep stages separate and avoids cross-stage challenges.
 - We can form smaller, more targeted classes.



Q: *Will my child need any additional resources?*

A: No, the school is providing all stationery and resources.



Q: *Will I get the opportunity to meet with my child's teachers?*

A: Absolutely. We will be organising opportunities for parents and carers to meet or speak with their child's teacher or teachers. If you would like to speak to a teacher in the meantime, please contact the school and we will organise a time.
