FOOD

Please do not have Doordash/Uber Eats delivered to school for your child. If your child has forgotten their lunch, please contact the school or canteen. If you drop off lunch late, please avoid fast food.

We encourage you to use the ice block buckets from the canteen for birthday celebrations rather than cakes/ lollies /snacks due to allergies.

This is for the safety of all our students



DROP OFF & PICK UP

Please wait in the designated waiting areas for your child in the afternoon. These areas are near the canteen, the main entrance gate, the Jetty Street gate and the back gate. Please **DO NOT** wait on the pathways or outside the classrooms. Please move away from the gate entrance, so our students can leave the grounds easily.

Remember to drop off at the gate each morning. The teachers are on duty from 8.30am. Please try to avoid sending your child before this time as there is no active supervision on the playground.



PAYMENTS, PERMISSION AND MEETINGS

Make sure you pay for events and grant permission prior to the closing date to avoid disappointment. There are usually many reminders sent. If you are having trouble with payments, please contact our lovely office ladies to help with a solution before the cut off date. We don't want our students missing out.

Please do not request parent meetings during school time, or try and catch the teacher at the beginning or end of the day. Send in your request and the teacher will make contact to organise a mutual time that will work for everyone.



ROAD & BIKE SAFETY

Crossing the road: Make sure you use the designated crossings at our exit gates. Our only gate without a crossing is the main entrance gate. Please take the time to walk up to the crossing. This short walk is better than time spent in hospital

Bike Safety: Students riding bikes and scooters must wear a helmet. They need to walk their bike to the school crossing. Students must ride sensibly for the safety of all pedestrians, not at extreme pace scaring pedestrians. Using a bell appropriately is a good start.

Parking: Park in designated parking spaces. The school carpark, crossings, bus bays and across driveways are not places to stop and drop off or pick up your child. 3-point turns should not take place next to a crossing.
