*** Applying to UAC - Early Bird Fee ***

The UAC Early Bird fee is a discounted application fee for NSW and ACT university admissions through the Universities Admissions Centre.

The Early Bird period closes at 11:59 pm on 30 September 2025. After this date, the UAC application processing fee increases from the Early Bird rate of \$82 to the Standard rate of \$215.

Educational Access Scheme (EAS)

Closing date for EAS applications - 18 Nov 2025
The Educational Access Scheme (EAS) helps UAC applicants who have encountered significant educational challenges. If you are eligible for consideration under the Educational Access Scheme and your ATAR is below the required selection rank for a course, an institution can increase your selection rank for that course, making you more competitive for a place.
