

## BYOL PROGRAM – LAPTOP SPECIFICATIONS

**Hardware Specifications:**

The laptop must meet **all** of the following requirements:

<b>Type of laptop</b>	Laptop or 2-in-1 device  *Mobile phones are not approved devices and iPads/tablets are not recommended*
<b>Physical Dimensions</b>	Minimum Screen Size: 10”
<b>Operating System</b>	Windows 11 ( <b>not</b> ‘S Mode’) – version 23H2 is recommended *Software compatibility cannot be guaranteed on other operating systems*
<b>Wireless Compatibility</b>	The laptop must support <b>5GHz band</b> and <b>Wi-Fi 4</b>  This may be advertised as “Dual Band Wireless”, “802.11n”, “802.11ac”, “802.11ax” or “Wi-Fi 7”  Laptops below version “Wi-Fi 4”, or that don’t support 5GHz band, will not connect to the school’s Wi-Fi  Please check these specifications with the vendor before purchasing
<b>Battery Life</b>	Advertised battery life of at least five hours

**\*\* Please take special note of the **Wireless Compatibility** requirements  
– this is the most important specification to ensure you get right \*\***

**Additional Considerations:**

The following are not essential but are suggestions as to what else you should consider:

<b>Recommendations</b>	Weight: ensure you select a laptop that is suitable for your child to carry  RAM: 8GB minimum (although 16GB is recommended)  Disk configuration: Solid State Drive (SSD) – minimum 128GB (240GB is recommended)  CPU: Pentium or equivalent minimum (i3 or above is recommended)
<b>Insurance</b>	Accidental loss and breakage insurance
