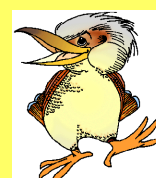

Kindy Ballet

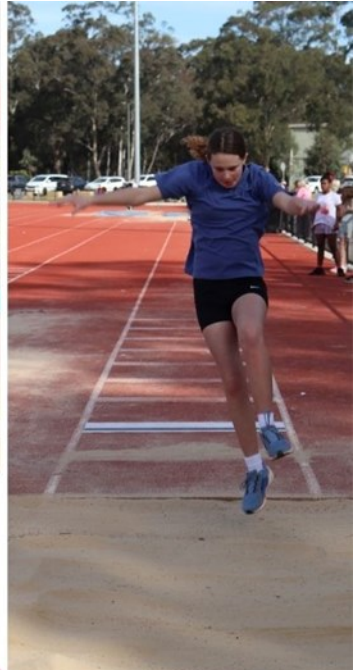
Next term we are offering our Kindergarten students something different in the area of dance. Ballet Without Borders (BWB) is a registered Australian charity which offers a unique holistic ballet experience to primary school aged children who would otherwise not be able to afford access to this powerful art form. They are coming to Kingswood South Public School next term to deliver a term of ballet classes for Kindergarten at no cost. They provide a regular teacher (with WWC clearance) who follows a specially designed BWB syllabus that teaches ballet in a fun and creatively expressive way and that aligns to many primary schools' curriculum objectives. No special uniforms or shoes are required from the students - just comfortable clothes and bare feet and/or socks.

The classes will cover:

- *Basic ballet movements and terminology
- *The rewards of practice and discipline
- *A new way of expressing thoughts, feelings and emotions
- * Ballet history and the stories of famous ballets such as The Nutcracker and Swan Lake

This will be a fun and enjoyable experience for our Students.

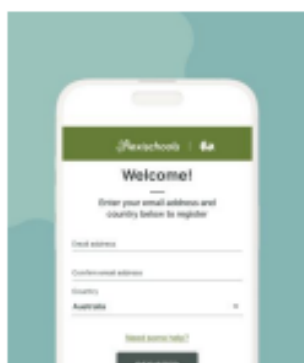
How to set up your Flexischools account

Simply [download the Flexischools App](#) from the Apple or Google stores and follow the prompts to create an account.

You can also signup through the Flexischools website flexischools.com.au

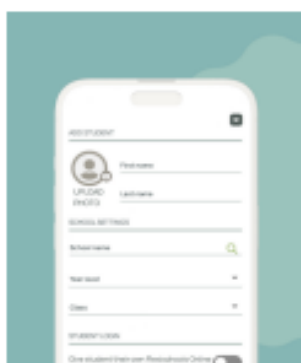


If you already have a Flexischools account you can simply add a new student to your existing account.



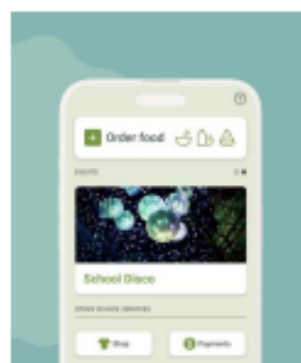
1. Download the app

The Flexischools app is the easiest way to place online lunch orders, buy school uniforms, and receive instant notifications from your school.



2. Register

- Open the Flexischools App and click 'Register'.
- Submit your email address to create an account.
- Go to your inbox and open the registration email from Flexischools.
- Click on the link and follow the registration process.



3. Log in to your Flexischools account and enter your child's details

- Select the 'Profile' icon on the navigation bar.
- Under 'Students', click 'Add new'.
- Enter your child's name, school, year level, and class.
- Click 'submit'.

How to order

- Click the 'Order Food' button at the top of the home page.
- Select which student you would like to place the order for.
- Choose which service, and date you would like to place the order for.
- Make your selections by adding items
- Click "View Order", then "Checkout & Pay"

Tip: Pay-as-you-go for each order, or top-up your Flexischools Wallet.

Student Login

Enter your child's email address so they can order their own lunch through their Flexischools account on their device. It's a great way for them to pick what they want, while you stay in control with daily spending limits and automatic top-ups. Simple and stress-free!

Cancelling your order

Orders can be cancelled through the Flexischools app prior to being sent to the canteen supplier each morning.

To cancel your order click on "Orders" in the Flexischools app and then click on the order you wish to cancel. If the order is still available to cancel, simply click on the cancel button. The full amount of your order will be refunded to your Flexischools Wallet.

If the order is not available to cancel, please contact your canteen supplier directly.

Fee & Charges

A 29c order fee is charged on every order placed through the Flexischools App. This fee is in addition to the cost of the canteen items and is charged at the time of purchase.

There is an additional surcharge for purchases or account top ups made by credit card, debit card or PayPal which is clearly detailed when you check out or add funds into your wallet. However, parents can top up their Flexischools wallet by Bank Transfer which incurs no surcharge. Click here to [view instructions](#).
