Kindergarten Calmsley Hill City Farm Excursion

Information about this excursion has gone home to families. The excursion takes place on Thursday the 4th September, 2025.

At the farm students will embark on a guided tour with their teacher, including the opportunity to pet animals. Students will learn about the needs of animals and plants that are grown for food. They will be able to enjoy a sheep shearing show, a stock whip demonstration, a working dog show and a tractor ride. The excursion has been planned to supplement and enhance student learning in HSIE, Science and Literacy.

P - 2 Sports Day

On Tuesday 9th September 2025 we will be holding our annual P-2 Sports Day in the school playground. All students in K-2 and the Preschool (Blue group) will be participating. They will need to wear their sports uniform, school hat and sneakers on that day. Your child's sport house and colour can be found in Sentral when you click on their picture. Students may choose to substitute their regular sport shirt for a shirt in their house colour if they wish – it is NOT mufti.

Student Absences

We understand that illness becomes an issue during winter, however when your child has been away we need the absence to be explained. The NSW Education Act requires that all student absences must be explained within 7 days of the first day of them being away from school. Please contact us promptly whenever your child is absent and let us know the reason for them being away. This allows us to provide the right support and make sure your child's absences are correctly recorded.

In the event that your child has repeated or ongoing unexplained absences, we will continue to try to contact you about each absence to provide appropriate support for you and your family. We are committed to working with you to offer support and remove any barriers that may be preventing your child from regularly

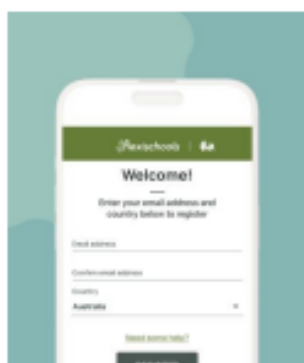
How to set up your Flexischools account

You can also signup through the Flexischools website flexischools.com.au

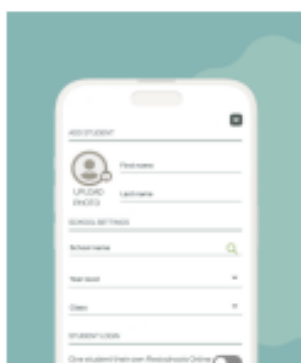


If you already have a Flexischools account you can simply add a new student to your existing account.



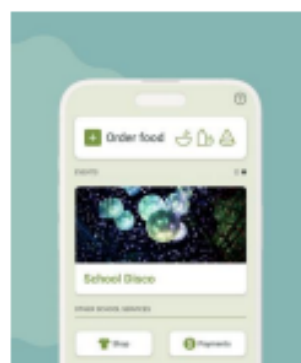
1. Download the app

The Flexischools app is the easiest way to place online lunch orders, buy school uniforms, and receive instant notifications from your school.



2. Register

- Open the Flexischools App and click 'Register'.
- Submit your email address to create an account.
- Go to your inbox and open the registration email from Flexischools.
- Click on the link and follow the registration process.



3. Log in to your Flexischools account and enter your child's details

- Select the 'Profile' icon on the navigation bar.
- Under 'Students', click 'Add new'.
- Enter your child's name, school, year level, and class.
- Click 'submit'.

How to order

- Click the 'Order Food' button at the top of the home page.
- Select which student you would like to place the order for.
- Choose which service, and date you would like to place the order for.
- Make your selections by adding items
- Click "View Order", then "Checkout & Pay"

Tip: Pay-as-you-go for each order, or top-up your Flexischools Wallet.

Student Login

Enter your child's email address so they can order their own lunch through their Flexischools account on their device. It's a great way for them to pick what they want, while you stay in control with daily spending limits and automatic top-ups. Simple and stress-free!

Cancelling your order

Orders can be cancelled through the Flexischools app prior to being sent to the canteen supplier each morning.

To cancel your order click on "Orders" in the Flexischools app and then click on the order you wish to cancel. If the order is still available to cancel, simply click on the cancel button. The full amount of your order will be refunded to your Flexischools Wallet.

If the order is not available to cancel, please contact your canteen supplier directly.

Fee & Charges

A 29c order fee is charged on every order placed through the Flexischools App. This fee is in addition to the cost of the canteen items and is charged at the time of purchase.

There is an additional surcharge for purchases or account top ups made by credit card, debit card or PayPal which is clearly detailed when you check out or add funds into your wallet. However, parents can top up their Flexischools wallet by Bank Transfer which incurs no surcharge. Click here to [view instructions](#).
